

2025-2026 School Year Tuition & Fees

Tuition rates for the 2025-2026 school year are listed by program below. Tuition may be paid in one annual payment or ten monthly payments (paid July 2025 – April 2026).

Sibling Discount

Emerging Minds Montessori Academy offers a 10% student discount for families with more than one student enrolled. The 10% discount is applied to the second student's tuition payment schedule along with all consecutive students.

Additional School Fees: (Returning and New Students)

After notification of acceptance and/or re-enrollment approval from the school's Admissions Director, families are required to complete the School Enrollment Packet and submit the following applicable non-refundable/non-transferable fees per student: Re-Enrollment Fee, Application Fee, Annual Security Fee, New Student Setup Fee, and Tuition Deposit. Payment options include ACH or Credit Card. We do not accept cash or checks. Additionally, please note a 4% credit card convenience fee applies to all credit card purchases.

Before and After Care Fees:

Emerging Minds Montessori Academy requires a yearly commitment and sign-up for before and after care programs. We offer supervised care for students before school (7:30 am) and after school (3:15 pm - 5:30 pm). **Please note a minimum number of students enrolled in each program is required for the program to be offered.**

Note: If a student is placed in aftercare due to late pick-up, an aftercare fee will be automatically applied to the student's account, payable upon receipt. Additionally, if aftercare is used more than three times without prior enrollment, your student will be automatically enrolled in the program.

Tuition and Fees Policies

- All tuition, deposits, and fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Tuition can be paid in full by July 1 to receive a 2% discount or in 10 equal monthly payments from July 1 to April 1. For monthly payments, tuition is due by the 7th of each month to avoid a \$55 late fee, which is applied to any outstanding balance. Additionally, a \$50 fee will apply for any non-sufficient fund (NSF) transactions. Late fees are applied monthly. Please note that late and NSF fees will not be waived. Prompt payment is appreciated. *Note: NSF and merchant fees are subject to change.*
- Payments that are later than 30 days may result in suspension of attendance until the matter is resolved.
- Tuition payments are made by ACH payment links or by credit card. A 4% convenience fee applies to all credit card payments.
- State-funded scholarships through FES-EO, FTC, and AAA will be acknowledged upon verification with appropriate documentation. Parents/Guardians assume responsibility for any tuition beyond the scholarship amount received.

Withdrawal Policy

Tuition obligations are non-refundable. Parents/Guardians understand and agree that the Student is enrolled for the entire school year, and the Parents/Guardians becomes liable for the entire year's tuition upon the signing of the Enrollment Contract. If thereafter the Student is withdrawn, absent, or expelled, the School will not refund any amounts paid and the Parents/Guardians remain responsible for the entire year's tuition and fees. The Parents/Guardians further agree that the obligation to pay tuition, fees, assessments, and charges ("financial obligations") for the entire school year is unconditional and that the withdrawal or absences by the Student from Emerging Minds Montessori Academy, for any reason, including illness, unsatisfactory academic progress, disciplinary suspension or expulsion, or failure to pay tuition in a timely manner, does not relieve the Parents/Guardians of the responsibility for payment of the entire year's financial obligations. Similarly, the Parents/Guardians remain solely responsible for payment of all financial obligations, regardless of whether the Parents/Guardians depend upon or anticipate other sources for funding. The Student is expected to participate actively in all aspects of school life. If, in the sole discretion of the Head of the School, the Student is persistently absent from classes, neglects work, fails to meet academic standards, exercises poor citizenship, or fails to cooperate, the Student may be asked to withdraw from the School. Cancellation under this paragraph will not relieve the Parents/Guardians of the responsibility for payment of the entire year's financial obligations. Emerging Minds Montessori Academy's Parents/Guardians are liable for the full tuition of the school year, or remainder thereof, when the student has been accepted for entry. There are no refunds for short-term absences due to illness or other reasons. Tuition is non-refundable including instances of absence, withdrawal, or dismissal for the following reasons: Riot, civil commotion, civil emergency, war, government order directed to the student or school, medical epidemic, weather, partial or total destruction of the school facility, or general economic panic or collapse.
